Background

The Center for Health and Safety Culture developed a survey to better understand the behaviors, beliefs, and attitudes of key leaders in rural Utah regarding seat belts. The survey was conducted using an online survey of a convenience sample of key leaders in Iron County in Utah in 2020. Local safety coalition members identified and recruited key leaders among a variety of sectors including local government, law enforcement, business and education to participate in the survey. These key leaders were also asked to forward the survey link using email to other leaders that they knew. The survey represents 35 individuals who participated in the survey, and the results cannot be generalized to all leaders in the county or to all leaders in Utah.

However, when it comes to adults, it should be their own choice. Adults should be able to decide for themselves which safety measures to take. The only exception would be when adults are transporting children under a certain age the adult should then be required to wear a seatbelt. The government should not mandate that every adult wear a seatbelt. There are situations where wearing a seatbelt can be problematic for some people i.e. certain health issues, prosthetics, etc. In similar fashion to deciding whether or not to take care of one's health, and adult should be able to decide whether or not they wear a seatbelt.
